## **RULES REGARDING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETINGS**

Persons wishing to address the Board at the appropriate place in the meeting agenda shall be subject to the following adopted rules:

1. Each person shall be allowed to speak on an agenda item when the issue is taken up by the Board for up to three minutes. An extension of time may be granted by the Township Supervisor if the extension will not interfere with the Township Board's business or with other persons who also wish to address the Board.
2. Each person shall be allowed to speak on any item for up to three minutes during public comment time. An extension of time may be granted by the chairman if the extension will not interfere with the Township Board's business or with other persons who also wish to address the board.
3. Each person wishing to address the Board shall identify themselves by name and address. Persons representing an organization or group shall indicate whether their comments represent the official view of the organization or group.
4. Each person wishing to address the board may do so one time. The Township Supervisor may allow a person to address the Board a second time in order to respond to earlier comments, but does not have to do so. Please note that repetitive comments are not necessary.
5. The Board shall be provided by the Clerk or by the speaker with copies of all written comments submitted.
6. Persons addressing the Board shall observe rules of common courtesy. Personal attacks against a Board member or township employee unrelated to the Board member's or employee's performance of duties are discouraged.

Board members may question speakers, but are not obligated to answer questions or make statements or commitments in response to issues raised by the public. In general, such issues will be referred to the Township Supervisor for investigation, study, and recommendation or designated as a future agenda item.
